In regard to the recommendation letter, the student must send the original along with his or her initial application. Students selected to receive the scholarship must provide originals of all the documents listed above.
- All application documents should be filled out in English. Documents not filled out in English must be
 accompanied with certified translations (or documents notarized by the embassy of the applicant's native
 country).
