The University of Sheffield is home to world-leading research, excellent teaching and a vibrant international community. Teaching quality

Whatever subjects students choose to study at the university, they will be taught and supervised by world-leading teachers, researchers and practitioners. Academic staff at the university are experts in their fields, and in the latest Research Exercise Framework 99% of Sheffield's research was rated as internationally recognised, excellent or world-leading. As a Russell Group university, teaching is driven by our research expertise and Sheffield is ranked 22nd out of 250 universities in Europe for teaching excellence (Times Higher Education Europe Teaching Rankings 2019).

During their time at Sheffield, students are encouraged to manage their own time to build upon vital organisational skills and prepare them for the world of work. In addition to becoming specialists in their chosen subject, students will develop their problem-solving, research, analytical, team working, and leadership skills, as well as increasing their confidence, and becoming resilient and adaptable.

The University of Sheffield works closely with business, industry, governments and international organisations to ensure that course content meets the demands of the field. Many courses feature alumni and guest lecturers who provide vital insight to students about their profession or industry.

Subject areas

The University of Sheffield is made up of <u>five academic faculties</u>, with an additional <u>International Faculty</u> based in Thessaloniki, Greece. Faculties include:

Faculty of Arts and Humanities

The University's arts and humanities has been recognised as world-leading, ranking 62nd in the Times Higher Education World University Rankings by Subject 2020. Departments include Archaeology, English, History, Languages and Cultures, Music and Philosophy.

Faculty of Engineering

Consisting of seven departments including Aerospace Engineering, Automatic Control and Systems Engineering, Bioengineering, Chemical and Biological Engineering, Civil and Structural Engineering, Computer Science, Electrical Engineering, Materials Science, and Mechanical Engineering.

Faculty of Medicine, Dentistry and Health

This faculty is home to the university's Medical School as well as departments in Dentistry, Health Sciences, Human Communication Sciences, Neuroscience, and Oncology and Metabolism.

Faculty of Science

Consists of seven departments including Animal and Plant Sciences, Biomedical Science, Chemistry, Mathematics and Statistics, Molecular Biology and Biotechnology, Physics and Astronomy, and Psychology.

Faculty of Social Sciences

The faculty is made up of 13 departments including the university's triple-crown accredited Management School, as well as the departments of Architecture, Economics, Education, Geography, Information School, Journalism, Landscape Architecture, Law, Politics, Sociology, Urban Studies and Planning, and the interdisciplinary Methods Institute. Sheffield's social sciences placed 59th globally in the Times Higher Education World University Rankings by Subject 2020.

Student life

Sheffield is a vibrant city which is close to some of the UK's most beautiful countryside. Home to more than half a million people, the city is the fourth biggest in the UK with an exciting music and arts scene. The city also boasts lots of outdoor space, including over 200 parks, beautiful gardens and woodland such as the Sheffield Botanical Gardens and Weston Park which are both a short walk from the main campus. Sheffield is a welcoming and friendly city, and it's one of the UK's most affordable student cities.

Guaranteed accommodation

The University of Sheffield guarantees to find students a place in their accommodation for the duration of their studies, providing they meet a <u>few simple conditions</u>. All <u>accommodation</u> includes a private bedroom and free Wi-Fi. The majority of rooms are en suite so students will have their own bathroom and WC.
