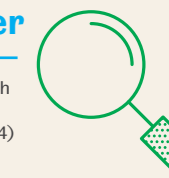

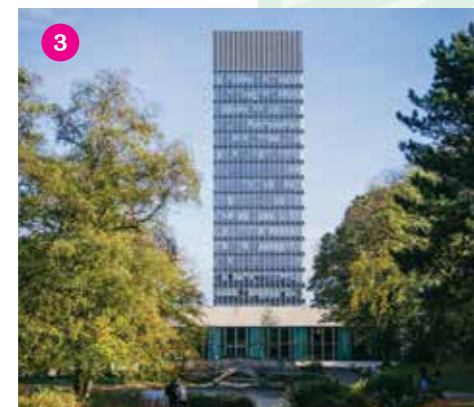

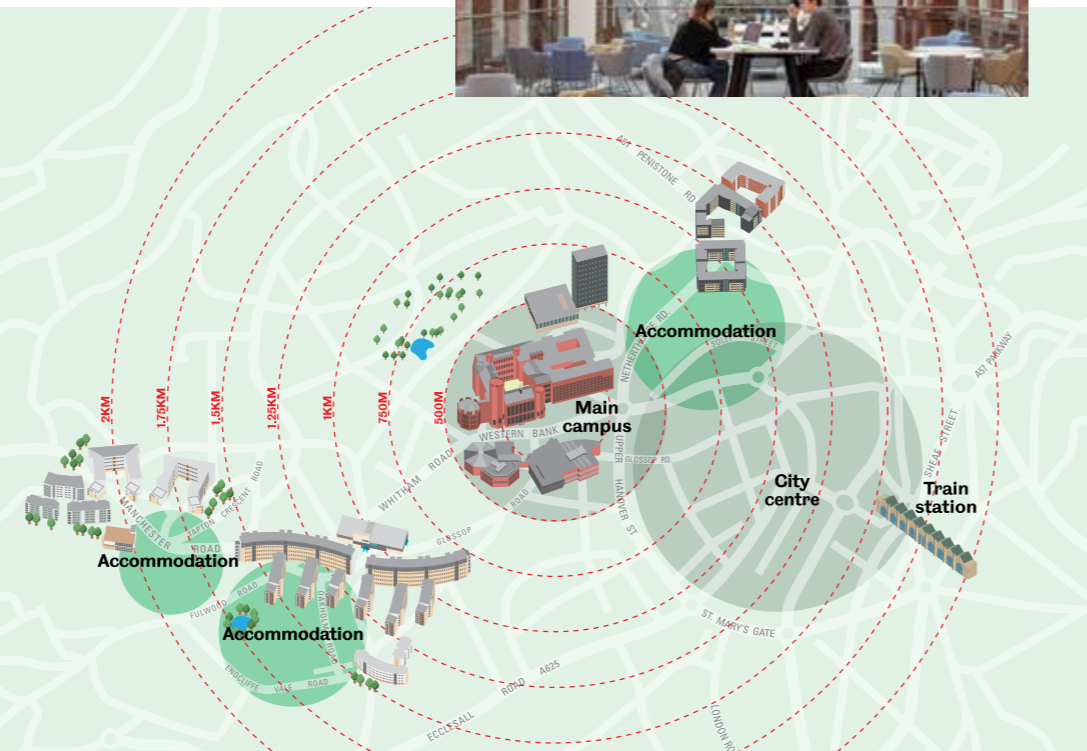
# World-class education
